FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO AN ARREST IN THE MURDER OF CARL DIENER

The Arlington County Police Department's Homicide/Robbery Unit is investigating a murder that occurred on Tuesday, December 29, 2009, in the 3200 block of N. 13th Street. The victim, Carl Diener, 57, of Arlington, was found deceased, lying in the street, the apparent victim of a stabbing.

A reward fund has been established by friends, businesses, concerned citizens, the family of Carl Diener, and Crime Solvers. The reward fund has a current value of over \$24,000 for information leading to the arrest of the person/persons who committed this crime. The private reward fund contribution is in excess of \$9000, while Crime Solvers offers \$1000. Callers to Crime Solvers do not have to give their names and do not need to testify in court.
