Police Seek Robbery Suspect

Surveillance Photos and Video Released

The Arlington County Police Department's Homicide/Robbery Unit is asking the public to help identify a man who robbed a pharmacy on July 10, 2008. Today, detectives released surveillance images of the suspect inside the CVS in the 4700 block of Lee Highway at approximately 9 p.m. The clerk told police the man displayed a large handgun and demanded money. The clerk was unable to provide cash, so the suspect settled for four cartons of cigarettes and fled the store.



The suspect is described as an African American male in his mid-forties, 5'6" to 5'10" tall and approximately 180 lbs. He had a grey patch or bald spot in the middle of his short dark hair. He wore a red and black FUBU jersey with the number 05 on the front.

Crime Solvers offers a reward of up to \$1,000 for information leading to arrest. Callers to Crime Solvers do not have to give their names and do not need to testify in court.
