Police Seek Bank Robbery Suspect

Surveillance Images Released

The Arlington County Police Department's Homicide/Robbery Unit is asking the public to help identify a woman who robbed a bank in South Arlington on February 19, 2008. Today, detectives released bank surveillance images of the suspect inside the bank. The woman entered the Bank of America branch, located at 3600 S. Glebe Road, at approximately 2:15 p.m. She handed a teller a note demanding money and implied she had a weapon. The teller placed an undisclosed amount of money in a bag supplied by the suspect. The suspect then took the bag and fled on foot.



She is described as a light skinned black or Hispanic female in her mid-twenties, 5'3" to 5'6" tall and approximately 130 lbs. She had brown shoulder length hair with blonde highlights. She wore a multi-colored jacket, blue jeans and oversized sunglasses.

Crime Solvers offers a reward of up to \$1,000 for information leading to arrest. Callers to Crime Solvers do not have to give their names and do not need to testify in court.
